A RESOLUTION

12 advocacy have earned him the admiration of colleagues and neighbors alike; and

13 WHEREAS, Reverend Chung has attained academic degrees from Huntingdon College and
14 the Claremont School of Theology, using his education for the betterment of his community
15 and church; and

16 WHEREAS, he has distinguished himself through both his ministry and exemplary record
17 as a community servant, and his outstanding accomplishments are hereby recognized.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 recognize and commend Reverend Minho Chung for his selfless devotion to service and
20 extend sincere gratitude for his words of scripture and prayer as Chaplain of the Day on
21 February 8, 2019.
