A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending *the Bert Show*; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, *the Bert Show* has been on the air continuously for almost two decades; is
3 recorded in Atlanta, Georgia; and airs on over a dozen radio networks across the nation; and

4 WHEREAS, Bert Weiss, Kristin Klingshirn, Davi Crimmins, Moe Mitchell, Cassie Young,
5 and the talented production crew team behind their microphones, led by Tracey Kenney and
6 Tommy Owen, have used their ability to provide relatable insights into the everyday
7 challenges that many Georgians face; and

8 WHEREAS, with its success, *the Bert Show* has given back to the community on many
9 separate occasions through service, including its sponsorship of vacations for children
10 suffering from chronic or terminal illnesses; and

11 WHEREAS, in a continuation of that same spirit of service, when contacted by a listener
12 about a difficult work environment brought on by her need to pump breast milk for her
13 nursing child, *the Bert Show* began an advocacy campaign to address public awareness of
14 and policy regarding nursing mothers at work; and

15 WHEREAS, through these efforts of civic education and citizen advocacy, *the Bert Show*
16 spurred a commendable interest in our state government among Georgia's citizens and moved
17 the General Assembly to action.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 commend *the Bert Show*, including all of its producers and staff, for their efforts to educate
20 and improve the lives of Georgians across this state.
