#### A RESOLUTION

17 the years; and

18 WHEREAS, Etowah Adams has personified the selfless dedication, mental agility, verbal  
19 adroitness, and personal maturity necessary for superlative academic performance; and

20 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia looks with great anticipation toward the future of this  
21 bright and promising young citizen.
