## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing March 7, 2014, as Cystic Fibrosis Education and Awareness Day at the state
- 2 capitol; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, each year, thousands of Americans, including many Georgians, are impacted
- 4 by cystic fibrosis (CF), which is a life-threatening, genetic disease that affects the lungs and
- 5 digestive systems; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation, a nonprofit entity with chapters across the
- 7 country and in Georgia, serves to find a cure for CF and to improve the quality of life for
- 8 people living with the disease; its core mission is to ensure that all people with CF have
- 9 access to high-quality, specialized CF care and treatments needed to live longer, healthier
- 10 lives; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation, a donor-supported nonprofit organization, is the
- world's leader in the search for a cure for cystic fibrosis, having raised and invested hundreds
- of millions of dollars to help develop CF drugs and therapies; and
- 14 WHEREAS, through the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation's efforts, the life expectancy of a child
- with CF has doubled in the last 30 years, and research to find a cure is more promising than
- 16 ever; however, even with the extraordinary progress that has been made, the lives of young
- 17 people with CF are still cut far too short; and
- 18 WHEREAS, through its unique venture philanthropy approach, the foundation invests in
- 19 promising CF research with leading pharmaceutical companies to accelerate treatment for
- 20 this rare disease; and
- 21 WHEREAS, the result is a robust pipeline of potential therapies, in various stages of
- 22 development and testing, aimed at targeting the disease from every angle; and

23 WHEREAS, the foundation's drug pipeline includes a breakthrough new therapy,

- 24 Kalydeco<sup>TM</sup>, which addresses the underlying cause of cystic fibrosis for a small portion of
- 25 those with the disease; the science behind Kalydeco<sup>TM</sup> has opened new doors to research and
- 26 development that may eventually lead to a cure for all people with CF; and
- 27 WHEREAS, states play a vital role in protecting access to specialized CF care and
- 28 treatments, with state programs helping more than half of all children and over a third of
- 29 adults with the disease afford their care; as new coverage measures are implemented, states
- 30 will become even more central to providing access to quality, specialized care; and
- 31 WHEREAS, through the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation's efforts, people with CF are living into
- 32 their 30s and beyond, but more needs to be done to help extend the lives of those with the
- disease; today, the CF Foundation urges elected officials to join us in its effort to add more
- 34 tomorrows to the lives of those affected by CF; and
- 35 WHEREAS, the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation has invested more than \$4 million in Georgia
- 36 in last several years for CF research and care initiatives, and looks to increase that level of
- 37 funding in the coming years; this state's commitment to this community is essential in
- 38 securing additional clinical trials to be conducted through its research hospitals.
- 39 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 40 recognize March 7, 2014, as Cystic Fibrosis Education and Awareness Day at the state
- 41 capitol, extend a warm greeting to the Georgia Chapter of the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation,
- 42 its staff and volunteers and the individuals and families who are served, convey to them this
- 43 legislative body's heartiest commendation for their past, present, and future work for those
- 44 individuals in this state, and encourage all citizens to support the Cystic Fibrosis chapters'
- 45 efforts raising awareness and research for the treatment and cure of cystic fibrosis.
- 46 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 47 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Georgia Chapter of the Cystic
- 48 Fibrosis Foundation, to the public, and to the press.
