A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the Joint Alternative Fuels Infrastructure and Vehicles Study Committee; and for
- 2 other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, as fuel economy and emissions standards become increasingly stringent,
- 4 alternative fuels are quickly becoming an attractive alternative to traditional gasoline and
- 5 diesel fuel; and
- 6 WHEREAS, vehicles fueled by alternative fuels are desirable and effective only if refueling
- 7 infrastructure is readily available to meet consumer needs; and
- 8 WHEREAS, because the consumer market is not yet established, station operators are
- 9 unwilling to invest in infrastructure equipment up front; and
- 10 WHEREAS, providing incentives for investors and operators to install the necessary
- 11 infrastructure for the efficient refueling of vehicles powered by alternative fuels may be
- 12 necessary to bring this nascent consumer market to fruition in Georgia and provide its
- 13 citizens with additional options; and
- 14 WHEREAS, it would be beneficial to study how providing market incentives for installation
- 15 of refueling infrastructure for alternative fuel vehicles would serve as a catalyst for the
- 16 realization of cheap and clean fueling options for the public and to study whether increased
- 17 market incentives for the purchase or lease of alternative fuel vehicles may drive
- 18 development of infrastructure.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 GEORGIA:
- 21 (1) **Creation of joint study committee.** There is created the Joint Alternative Fuels
- Infrastructure and Vehicles Study Committee.

23 (2) **Members and officers.** The committee shall be composed of the following ten members:

- 25 (A) The President of the Senate shall appoint five members of the Senate as members of the committee and shall designate one of such members as cochairperson.
- 27 (B) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint five members of the House of Representatives as members of the committee and shall designate one of such members as cochairperson.
- 30 (3) **Powers and duties.** The committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs, issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action or
- legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate.
- 33 (4) **Meetings.** The cochairpersons shall call all meetings of the committee. The committee may conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform
- its duties, and accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution.
- 37 (5) **Allowances and funding.** The legislative members of the committee shall receive
- the allowances provided for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 39 Annotated. The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by any
- 40 member of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized.
- Funds necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from funds
- appropriated to the Senate and the House of Representatives.
- 43 (6) **Report.**

- (A) In the event the committee adopts any specific findings or recommendations that include suggestions for proposed legislation, the cochairpersons shall file a report of the same prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution, subject to subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.
- (B) In the event the committee adopts a report that does not include suggestions for proposed legislation, the cochairpersons shall file the report, subject to subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.
- 51 (C) No report shall be filed unless the same has been approved prior to the date of
- abolishment specified in this resolution by majority vote of a quorum of the committee.
- A report so approved shall be signed by the cochairpersons of the committee and filed with the Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House of Representatives.
- 55 (D) In the absence of an approved report, the cochairpersons may file with the 56 Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House of Representatives copies of the
- 57 minutes of the meetings of the committee in lieu thereof.
- 58 (7) **Abolishment.** The committee shall stand abolished on December 1, 2016.
