

Senate Resolution 1045

A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Georgia residents who have type 1 diabetes and whose families continually
2 educate and advocate and recognizing March 26, 2020, as Type 1 Diabetes Day at the state
3 capitol; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, type 1 diabetes is an autoimmune disease which causes a person's pancreas to
5 stop producing insulin, a hormone that enables people to produce energy from food. It
6 occurs when the body's immune system attacks and destroys the insulin-producing cells in
7 the pancreas, called the beta cells. Its onset has nothing to do with diet or lifestyle. There
8 is no prevention for type 1 diabetes and, at present, no cure; and

9 WHEREAS, type 1 diabetes strikes both children and adults. It comes on suddenly, causes
10 dependence on artificial insulin for life, and carries the constant threat of devastating
11 complications up to, and including, death; and

12 WHEREAS, there are more than 3 million children and adults living with type 1 diabetes;
13 and

14 WHEREAS, more than 8,000 children and an unknown number of adults in Georgia live
15 with type 1 diabetes; and

16 WHEREAS, each year in this state, there are approximately 500 children and an unknown
17 number of adults who are diagnosed with type 1 diabetes; and

18 WHEREAS, there is a need for education to increase knowledge, encourage advocacy, and
19 promote safe care for those living with this disease; and

20 WHEREAS, a key goal of the Team Type 1 Foundation, a nonprofit organization located in
21 Georgia, is to ensure sustainable access to medicine and tools for all people with diabetes
22 across not only this great state, but the world; and

23 WHEREAS, the foundation's ultimate goal is to find a cure for this disease and turn type 1
24 into "Type None," so that people can live healthy, fulfilling lives.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
26 commend the Georgia residents who have type 1 diabetes and whose families continually
27 educate and advocate and recognize March 26, 2020, as Type 1 Diabetes Day at the state
28 capitol.

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
30 to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to Della H. Stoner,
31 organizer of Type 1 Diabetes Day at the state capitol.
