

Senate Resolution 1049

**ADOPTED SENATE**

**A RESOLUTION**

1 Creating the Senate Cross Media Development Study Committee; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the entertainment industry is becoming more reliant on cross media  
3 technologies in the production of films, games, animation, and music; and

4 WHEREAS, attracting and retaining companies in this state that create films, games,  
5 animation, and music will depend on having a qualified labor pool in the state trained and  
6 educated in the technologies required for cross media; and

7 WHEREAS, becoming a center of cross media development will both enhance the career  
8 opportunities for Georgia's youth and serve broadly as an engine for economic development;  
9 and

10 WHEREAS, a study is needed on how to best position Georgia as a hub for cross media  
11 development.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

13 (1) **Creation of Senate study committee.** There is created the Senate Cross Media  
14 Development Study Committee.

15 (2) **Members and officers.** The committee shall be composed of seven members of the  
16 Senate to be appointed by the President of the Senate. The President shall designate one  
17 member of the committee as chairperson of the committee.

18 (3) **Powers and duties.** The committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs,  
19 issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action or  
20 legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate.

21 (4) **Meetings.** The chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee. The committee  
22 may conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or  
23 convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and  
24 accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution.

25 (5) **Allowances and funding.**

26 (A) The legislative members of the committee shall receive the allowances provided  
27 for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated.

28 (B) The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by any member  
29 of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized. Funds  
30 necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from funds  
31 appropriated to the Senate.

32 (6) **Report.**

33 (A) In the event the committee adopts any specific findings or recommendations that  
34 include suggestions for proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file a report of the  
35 same prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution, subject to  
36 subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.

37 (B) In the event the committee adopts a report that does not include suggestions for  
38 proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file the report, subject to subparagraph (C)  
39 of this paragraph.

40 (C) No report shall be filed unless the same has been approved prior to the date of  
41 abolishment specified in this resolution by majority vote of a quorum of the committee.  
42 A report so approved shall be signed by the chairperson of the committee and filed with  
43 the Secretary of the Senate.

44 (D) In the absence of an approved report, the chairperson may file with the Secretary  
45 of the Senate a copy of the minutes of the meetings of the committee in lieu thereof.

46 (7) **Abolishment.** The committee shall stand abolished on December 1, 2018.
