## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending State Representative Rich Golick and congratulating him upon the grand  
2 occasion of his retirement from the Georgia House of Representatives; and for other  
3 purposes.

4 WHEREAS, Rich Golick served as a law clerk in the criminal division of the Justice  
5 Department in Washington, D.C., during the administration of President George H. W. Bush  
6 and subsequently clerked in the criminal division of the U.S. Attorney's Office; and

7 WHEREAS, he has served in the Georgia House of Representatives since 1999 and is  
8 currently representing the 40th State House District, which includes parts of Smyrna,  
9 Vinings, Mableton, and Atlanta; and

10 WHEREAS, in 2008, he was presented the Legislator of the Year Award for his legislative  
11 work on behalf of Georgia consumers; and

12 WHEREAS, in 2010, he was again presented with the Legislator of the Year Award on  
13 behalf of the Georgia Chamber of Commerce for his work in combating identity fraud; and

14 WHEREAS, the Georgia Association of Educators presented Representative Golick with its  
15 Legislator of the Year Award in 2007 for his work in strengthening Georgia's whistleblower  
16 law; and

17 WHEREAS, in 1998, he established the State House Scholarship, which is an ongoing annual  
18 college tuition scholarship benefiting the higher education of a graduating senior from the  
19 40th State House District; and

20 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the numerous accomplishments of this  
21 exemplary Georgian be appropriately recognized.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
23 commend Representative Rich Golick and congratulate him upon the grand occasion of his  
24 retirement from the Georgia House of Representatives.
