A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing April, 2018, as Child Abuse Prevention Month at the state capitol; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, child abuse is a serious and growing problem, which affects more than 3.2
4 million of our nation's children annually; and

5 WHEREAS, this societal malignancy called child abuse respects no race, religion, class or
6 geographic boundary, and, in fact, has been declared a national emergency; and

7 WHEREAS, the Georgia District Exchange Clubs and the Georgia Exchange Foundation for
8 the Prevention of Child Abuse, Inc., through their important programs and services, are
9 making significant progress in putting an end to this crime against families and children; and

10 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the cruelty and severity of child abuse
11 within this nation be addressed through the recognition of Child Abuse Prevention Month.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
13 recognize April, 2018, as Child Abuse Prevention Month at the state capitol.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
15 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the public and the
16 press.
