A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Motor Carrier Compliance Division; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Motor Carrier Compliance Division has been recognized as one of the most
4 dynamic programs in Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, this outstanding program has had a tremendous impact through its desire to
6 improve the quality of life in Georgia and has established a glowing reputation of renown for
7 its dedication and high ideals; and

8 WHEREAS, the Motor Carrier Compliance Division remains steadfastly committed to the
9 principles of skill, integrity, and responsibility, and was awarded top honors as the Highest
10 Achieving Safety Enforcement Program in 2016 and honorable mention as the Greatest
11 Improvement in Safety Enforcement from 2015 to 2016, the first time in history that it has
