A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring and remembering the life of the Honorable Zell Bryan Miller, former Lieutenant
- 2 Governor, Governor, and United States Senator of this great state; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the Honorable Zell Bryan Miller was born on February 24, 1932, in Young
- 4 Harris, Georgia, to Stephen Grady Miller and Birdie Miller, one of Georgia's most
- 5 distinguished native sons; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he attended Young Harris College and later earned bachelor's and master's
- 7 degrees in history from the University of Georgia and entered the teaching profession as a
- 8 history and political science professor at Young Harris College; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he served his country with honor and distinction in the United States Marine
- 10 Corps from 1953 to 1956, leaving the Corps as a Sergeant and Rifle Expert; and
- 11 WHEREAS, during a forty-year career in public service, he served the State of Georgia as
- 12 a Mayor, State Senator, Lieutenant Governor, Governor, and United States Senator; and
- 13 WHEREAS, he won the first of four consecutive terms as Lieutenant Governor of Georgia
- 14 from 1975 to 1991, becoming the longest-serving Lieutenant Governor in Georgia history;
- 15 and
- 16 WHEREAS, he was elected Governor in 1990 and served as Georgia's 79th Governor from
- 17 1991-1999; and
- 18 WHEREAS, he served as United States Senator from Georgia from 2000 to 2004; and
- 19 WHEREAS, he had a passion for education and contributed greatly to the cause of education
- 20 in Georgia in many ways, most notably through the creation of the highly successful HOPE
- 21 Scholarship program for students at Georgia's colleges, universities, and technical institutes

22 and the nation's first state-wide voluntary pre-kindergarten for all four-year-olds whose

- parents wanted to enroll them; and
- 24 WHEREAS, upon retiring from the United States Senate in 2004, he returned to the
- 25 classroom as a professor at the University of Georgia, Emory University, and Young Harris
- 26 College; and
- 27 WHEREAS, in 2008, the Zell B. Miller Learning Center at the University of Georgia was
- dedicated in his honor; in 2014, the Zell and Shirley Miller Library at Young Harris College
- 29 was dedicated in the couple's honor; and in 2016, the Miller Institute was created to preserve,
- 30 promote, and continue the Miller legacy; and
- 31 WHEREAS, on the morning of March 23, 2018, he died peacefully at his home in Young
- 32 Harris surrounded by his beloved wife Shirley and his family; and
- 33 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of this monumental statesman and
- 34 distinguished Georgian.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 36 join together to express their deepest regret at the passing of former Lieutenant Governor,
- 37 Governor, and United States Senator Zell Bryan Miller and extend their most sincere
- 38 condolences to his family.
- 39 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
