- been killed over the years at the club, including that of Charles Foster, Jr., a young man who
- died as a result of gun violence at Club Majestic; and
- 14 WHEREAS, an adamant advocate for the young people of Columbus, Reverend Phillips will
- 15 keep pushing for the closing of Club Majestic to prevent devastating scenarios; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Reverend Phillips has demonstrated his passion and dedication for the safety
- 17 of young people in Columbus, and it is only fitting and proper that the work of this
- 18 outstanding Georgian be recognized.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
