19 WHEREAS, she retired from the Fayette County School System in 2005, and her vision and
20 unyielding commitment to education and her community have set the standard for service;

22 WHEREAS, she continues to stay engaged in the community as a volunteer with the Atlanta
23 Youth Academy; a member of Delta Kappa Gamma; and a member and volunteer at the King
24 Center, for the Rainbow Push Coalition, and for the Concerned Black Citizens of Clayton

26 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
27 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
