A RESOLUTION

19 the love of his life, Lillie F. Grafton Linsey, has led his family of three children, eight
20 grandchildren, and seven great-grandchildren with love, strength, and faith; and

21 WHEREAS, Wallace V. Linsey, Sr., is respected and well-liked by the members of this body
22 and will truly be missed as he moves on to other pursuits; and

23 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that Wallace V. Linsey, Sr., be recognized
24 on the grand occasion of his retirement from the Georgia State Senate.
