### A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Liberty Schultz, Madison Kessel, and Jessica Thompson; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, National History Day in Georgia is a program of Georgia Humanities in  
4 partnership with LaGrange College and Mercer University that inspires in American students  
5 a passion for history; and

6 WHEREAS, more than half a million children from across the country compete in this event  
7 annually, conducting research and producing websites, papers, performances, and  
8 documentaries to tell the human story; and

9 WHEREAS, Liberty Schultz, Madison Kessel, and Jessica Thompson finished first place in  
10 Georgia's National History Day Senior Group Documentary competition and second place  
11 at the National History Day Senior Group Documentary competition; and

12 WHEREAS, Liberty, Madison, and Jessica collaborated on their documentary outside of  
13 their school activities and were supervised by Heather Schultz; and

14 WHEREAS, their documentary was titled *Eunice Kennedy Shriver: The Backyard Vision and*  
15 *a Global Legacy*.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
17 commend and congratulate Liberty Schultz, Madison Kessel, and Jessica Thompson on  
18 finishing first place in Georgia's National History Day Senior Group Documentary  
19 competition and second place at the National History Day Senior Group Documentary  
20 competition.
