## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Democratic Party of Clayton County and the Young  
2 Democrats of Clayton County; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the members of the Clayton County Democratic Party are under the capable  
4 leadership of Chairperson Larry W. Bussey, 1st Vice Chair Janice Scott, 2nd Vice Chair
