## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the Senate Study Committee on Medicaid Care Management Organizations
- 2 Credentialing; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, states are increasingly adopting managed care as a response to growing
- 4 Medicaid expenditures; and
- 5 WHEREAS, credentialing is a necessary and critical first step in securing qualified
- 6 practitioners to render and manage care under Medicaid care management organizations; and
- 7 WHEREAS, federal regulations give states considerable latitude to create their own uniform
- 8 credentialing and recredentialing policies and procedures, and states are required to establish
- 9 uniform credentialing policies; and
- 10 WHEREAS, these requirements include a documented process for credentialing providers
- 11 that have signed contracts or participation agreements with Medicaid managed care entities;
- 12 and
- 13 WHEREAS, in Georgia, the lack of a standardized credentialing application for use in
- 14 credentialing providers creates increased paperwork and delay in the critical credentialing
- 15 process; and
- 16 WHEREAS, in Georgia, the credentialing application process often takes more than 120 days
- and in some areas involves multiple applications; and
- 18 WHEREAS, because the credentialing process is a critical part of securing qualified
- 19 practitioners to render and manage care under care management organizations, it is crucial
- 20 to adopt and use effective policies; and

21 WHEREAS, a study is needed to establish a standardized credentialing application process

- 22 and to provide a reasonable application response time from the care management
- 23 organization and to provide for criteria for time extensions to such application response time.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that there is created the Senate
- 25 Study Committee on Medicaid Care Management Organizations Credentialing to be
- 26 composed of seven members to be appointed by the President of the Senate. The President
- 27 of the Senate shall designate one of the appointees as chairperson. The committee shall meet
- at the call of the chairperson.
- 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee shall undertake a study of the conditions,
- 30 needs, issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any actions
- 31 or legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate. The committee may
- 32 conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or
- 33 convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and
- 34 accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution. All agencies of the state are
- 35 directed to provide the committee with such assistance as the committee shall require to
- 36 perform its assigned duties. In the event the committee makes a report of its findings and
- 37 recommendations, with suggestions for proposed legislation, if any, such report shall be
- made on or before December 1, 2014, at which time the committee shall stand abolished.
