A RESOLUTION

- 1 Encouraging law enforcement agencies to equip peace officers who conduct traffic stops or
- 2 respond to emergency dispatch calls as their primary duty with body cameras; and for other
- 3 purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, this body is committed to the safety of peace officers in the performance of their
- 5 essential public safety responsibilities; and
- 6 WHEREAS, a citizenry with an awareness that encounters with peace officers are being
- 7 recorded produces more socially desirable behavior among citizens in their encounters with
- 8 peace officers; and
- 9 WHEREAS, peace officers equipped with body cameras are often less likely to need to use
- 10 force or to face a citizen complaint.
- 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 12 join together to encourage law enforcement agencies to equip peace officers who conduct
- traffic stops or respond to emergency dispatch calls as their primary duty with body cameras
- 14 to record audio and video depictions of such encounters with peace officers.
- 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 16 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the Department of
- 17 Public Safety.
