## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing Wednesday, February 13, 2013, as Lupus Awareness Day; and for other
- 2 purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, lupus is an acute, chronic, and life-long autoimmune disease in which the
- 4 immune system is unbalanced, causing inflammation and tissue damage to virtually every
- 5 organ system in the body; and
- 6 WHEREAS, lupus can affect any part of the body, including the skin, lungs, heart, kidneys,
- 7 and brain, causing seizures, strokes, heart attacks, miscarriages, and organ failure; and
- 8 WHEREAS, while lupus strikes mostly women of childbearing age, it can also affect men
- 9 and children; African Americans, Hispanics/Latinos, Asians, and Native Americans are two
- 10 to three times more likely to develop lupus, a disparity that remains unexplained; and
- 11 WHEREAS, at least 1.5 million Americans, including approximately 55,000 Georgians, are
- 12 currently living with lupus; and
- WHEREAS, lupus is a major health issue that has a significant impact on the economy of
- 14 this state and takes an immeasurable physical, financial, and emotional toll on many families
- in Georgia; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the effects of lupus on a family can be devastating in that it is a chronic,
- 17 lifelong, and life-threatening disease, and despite its prevalence, it remains one of the least
- 18 recognizable and most misunderstood diseases, labeling lupus as the *cruel mystery*; and
- 19 WHEREAS, the Lupus Foundation of America is the nation's leading nonprofit voluntary
- 20 health organization, dedicated to finding the causes and a cure for lupus while providing
- 21 support and services to all people affected by the disease; and

22 WHEREAS, 90 percent of every dollar raised by the Georgia Chapter of the Lupus

- 23 Foundation of America stays in Georgia to support the chapter's programs; and
- 24 WHEREAS, the Lupus Foundation of America provides resources for thousands of patients
- and families, including support and information, physician referrals, public and professional
- 26 education, and grassroots advocacy on the state and federal levels.
- 27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 28 commend the work of the Lupus Foundation of America and other organizations devoted to
- 29 finding a cure for lupus and to supporting the individuals and families whose lives are
- 30 affected by this autoimmune disease and recognize Wednesday, February 13, 2013, as Lupus
- 31 Awareness Day at the state capitol.
- 32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 33 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Georgia Chapter of the Lupus
- 34 Foundation of America.
