A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Liz Flowers and thanking her for her service as Executive Director of the
2 Georgia Senate Democratic Caucus; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Liz Flowers began working with the Georgia Senate Democratic Caucus in
4 2011, when she was hired by then Democratic Leader Robert Brown; and

5 WHEREAS, prior to working with the Georgia Senate Democratic Caucus, Liz Flowers had
6 an accomplished career working in both media and politics, both in Georgia and nationwide,
7 including serving as the Vice President of Public Affairs and Marketing for Planned
8 Parenthood of Los Angeles, as the Associate Director for Administration for the ACLU of
9 Southern California, and owned, published, and managed *The Post News* in Georgia; and

10 WHEREAS, Liz Flowers currently serves as the principal of e/flowers and associates that
11 provides consulting services to a wide range of clients in addition to the Georgia Senate
12 Democratic Caucus, including the Fulton County School System, MARTA, the Grady
13 Foundation, and numerous political campaigns; and

14 WHEREAS, in her time working for the Georgia Senate Democratic Caucus Liz helped the
15 caucus grow into a scrappy insurgency that is today able to influence the legislature and
16 effect policy despite its small numbers; and

17 WHEREAS, the effectiveness of the Georgia Senate Democratic Caucus was recognized for
18 its effectiveness during Liz's tenure by its receipt of the 2013 Arnie Award for being the
19 "Productive Pranksters" of the Georgia General Assembly; and

20 WHEREAS, Liz now will be taking her next step in her political journey by accepting the
21 role of Communications Director for Demos, a progressive advocacy group in New York.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
23 recognize and thank Liz Flowers for her service with the Georgia Senate Democratic Caucus.
