A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the Georgia Rural Health Association and recognizing March 1, 2017, as Rural
- 2 Health Day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the Georgia Rural Health Association is a nonprofit advocate for rural health
- 4 care consumers and dedicated health care professionals who serve rural Georgia and
- 5 encourages the development of an improved health care system throughout this state; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Georgia has 109 rural counties encompassing more than 2 million residents, and
- 7 there is a continuing decline in the availability and quality of health care providers,
- 8 specialists, nurses, and professional services; and
- 9 WHEREAS, these geographic areas have the highest cancer and cardiovascular mortality
- 10 rates; in addition, infant mortality, child abuse, and teen pregnancy rates and the growing
- uninsured population and elderly population with multiple diseases far exceed the area's
- 12 health care resources; and
- 13 WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Community Health recognizes that the limited
- availability and quality of rural health care facilities and services further aggravate the area's
- 15 distressed economy and deter industry recruitment; and
- 16 WHEREAS, state and federal officials need to focus on the plight of rural communities and
- 17 the need for better access to health care, workforce development and training, access to
- 18 capital for aging health care facilities, and medical malpractice tort reform.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 20 commend the efforts of the Georgia Rural Health Association and recognize March 1, 2017,
- 21 as Rural Health Day at the state capitol.
