## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February 23, 2023, as Egyptian American Day in Georgia; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Egyptian-American community has exhibited resilience and sacrifice in  
4 establishing the State of Georgia as a place to live, work, and thrive; and

5 WHEREAS, the Egyptian-American community actively contributes to the ongoing welfare  
6 and continued prosperity of the state through community service and volunteerism; and

7 WHEREAS, Egyptian Americans have achieved the highest levels of leadership in business,  
8 healthcare, technology, education, and law, among other industries; and

9 WHEREAS, the Egyptian-American community has established a significant presence in the  
10 United States and in the State of Georgia at large, embracing leadership roles and assisting  
11 to create the next generation of Egyptian American leaders; and

12 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper to honor the more than 3,000 members of the  
13 Egyptian-American community for their outstanding economic, cultural, and educational  
14 contributions and continued legacy in the State of Georgia.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
16 recognize February 23, 2023, as Egyptian American Day in Georgia.
