A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Mothers Against Drunk Driving Georgia; and for other
- 2 purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD) Georgia is a nonprofit organization
- 4 that serves all 159 counties in this state and whose members include not only mothers but all
- 5 sorts of people who have been dedicated to its cause for 40 years; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the mission of MADD is to end drunk driving, help fight drugged driving,
- 7 support the victims of these violent crimes, and prevent underage drinking; and
- 8 WHEREAS, MADD works to raise awareness about the dangers of drinking and driving
- 9 through public education, including MADD's Power of Parents and Power of YOU(th)
- 10 programs, and to make impaired driving laws tougher through their campaign to eliminate
- 11 drunk driving; and
- 12 WHEREAS, MADD offers an array of services to bereaved crash victims and injured crash
- 13 survivors at no charge, including providing assistance; emotional support; information on the
- legal system, financial issues, victim's rights, and victim compensation; a DUI memorial sign

16 WHEREAS, MADD provides an outlet for crash survivors and grieving families through

- 17 their victim impact panels, victim vigils, Mission Moments, and Walk Like MADD; and
- 18 WHEREAS, MADD works to protect children by educating others on child endangerment
- 19 in relation to drunk and impaired driving; and
- 20 WHEREAS, MADD recognizes law enforcement's efforts to protect citizens from drunk and
- 21 impaired driving on Georgia roads through their annual Golden Shield Honors; and
- WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the life-saving work of this organization
- and its numerous contributions to the citizens of this state be recognized.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 25 recognize and commend Mothers Against Drunk Driving Georgia for its efforts to raise
- 26 awareness of the dangers of drunk and impaired driving, create tougher impaired driving
- 27 laws, support the victims and families of these crimes, and stop people from drinking and
