A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Captain Thornell "T.K." King, Cornell L. Harvey, Johnny
- 2 Robinson, and Clainetta T. Jefferson for their dedication to the community of Southeast
- 3 Georgia; and for other purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, Captain Thornell "T.K." King, Cornell L. Harvey, Johnny Robinson, and
- 5 Clainetta T. Jefferson have immeasurably contributed to the Southeast Georgia coastal
- 6 community through their tremendous acts of service; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Captain Thornell King, otherwise known as "T.K.," is a native of Darien,
- 8 Georgia, where he was a former standout high school athlete at McIntosh County, and he
- 9 later attended Morehouse College and played baseball; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Captain King returned to his alma mater as a coach and teacher and has since
- served as a Georgia state trooper and devoted his life to serving the people in his community
- and neighboring counties through his countless acts of kindness and charity; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Captain Thornell King and his wife, Kim, have one son and continue to give
- back to those in need and serve as leaders in the coastal Georgia region; and

15 WHEREAS, Cornell L. Harvey has served as the first African American mayor of

- 16 Brunswick, Georgia, since December 2013 and has led his community through numerous
- 17 challenges including homelessness, natural disasters, and the tragic death of Ahmaud Arbery;
- 18 and
- 19 WHEREAS, Cornell L. Harvey attended Glynn Academy High School, from which he
- 20 graduated in 1971, and he then enlisted in the United States Air Force and served his country
- 21 for 29 years, achieving the highest enlisted rank of chief master sergeant; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Mayor Harvey is also a graduate of the University of Maryland and earned a
- 23 master's degree in public administration from Troy State University; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Cornell L. Harvey has championed the improvement of Brunswick's most
- 25 underserved neighborhoods and has broken down a countless number of barriers to expertly
- 26 lead his community; and
- 27 WHEREAS, Johnny Robinson bravely served in the United States Army during World War
- 28 II, a time when many questioned if African Americans were patriotic enough to serve their
- 29 country, and earned the rank of corporal while serving in an integrated anti-aircraft artillery
- 30 unit; and
- 31 WHEREAS, Johnny Robinson was stationed in Pearl Harbor, Camp Stewart, and Camp Bliss
- 32 and received orders to Okinawa, where he fought in one of the bloodiest invasions of the war
- and valiantly endured kamikaze attacks, typhoons, and numerous other trials of war; and

34 WHEREAS, Johnny Robinson is the recipient of the World War II Victory Medal,

- 35 Asiatic-Pacific Campaign Medal, Good Conduct Medal, sharpshooter badge, and multiple
- others and serves as a beacon of patriotism within the Camden County community; and
- 37 WHEREAS, Clainetta T. Jefferson was born in Tallahassee, Florida, and was raised in
- 38 Albany, Georgia, where she graduated from Westover High School and went on to attend the
- 39 Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University (FAMU), where she earned an
- 40 undergraduate degree in accounting; and
- 41 WHEREAS, Clainetta Jefferson moved to Houston and worked as an auditor for Price
- 42 Waterhouse and the Aramco Services Company and later married a local pastor, Aaron
- 43 Jefferson Jr., who was an officer in the United States Navy, and they later moved to Parris
- 44 Island, South Carolina, where she changed her career from business to education and earned
- a master's degree in education from the University of South Carolina; and
- 46 WHEREAS, Clainetta Jefferson and her husband have served Naval Submarine Base Kings
- 47 Bay since 2008, where she now serves as the school liaison officer for the installation and
- 48 is an educational consultant for military families with students in grades K-12; and
- 49 WHEREAS, Clainetta Jefferson also earned a graduate degree in education and human
- 50 development from The George Washington University and has developed programs which
- 51 directly impact military children in Camden County and across the State of Georgia; and
- 52 WHEREAS, Clainetta Jefferson has been married for nearly 36 years, is the proud mother
- of three military children, and is an active member of Kingsland First Baptist Church, while
- also serving on a host of community boards and committees seeking to better the local
- 55 community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body

- 57 recognize and commend Captain Thornell "T.K." King, Cornell L. Harvey, Johnny Robinson,
- 58 and Clainetta T. Jefferson for their dedication to the betterment of Southeast Georgia.
