- and also fulfilled temporary duty assignments in New Mexico at Cannon Air Force Base;
- 16 after four years of active duty and two years active in the reserves, she was honorably
- 17 discharged as a Staff Sergeant (E-5); and
- 18 WHEREAS, our nation's security continues to rely on the brave and dedicated military
- 19 heroes who stand ever ready to lay the ultimate sacrifice upon the altar of freedom; and
- 20 WHEREAS, this distinguished gentlewoman has given inspiration to many through her high
- 21 ideals, morals, and deep concern for her fellow citizens, and she possesses the vast wisdom
- 22 which only comes through experience and the strength of character which is achieved
