## ADOPTED SENATE

## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to provide that the General Assembly may
- 2 by general law authorize local boards of education to impose, levy, and collect development
- 3 impact fees, subject to local referendum, and use the proceeds to pay for a share of the cost
- 4 of additional educational facilities; to provide for the submission of this amendment for
- 5 ratification or rejection; and for other purposes.

## 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

8 Article VIII, Section VI of the Constitution is amended by adding a new Paragraph to read 9 as follows:

- 10 "Paragraph V. Development impact fees for educational purposes. The General
- 11 Assembly is authorized to provide by general law that each local board of education may
- by resolution impose, levy, and collect development impact fees within any area of its
- school system which is experiencing new growth and development conditioned upon
- 14 approval by a majority of the qualified voters residing within the limits of the local taxing
- 15 jurisdiction voting in a referendum thereon. A county or municipality that has received a
- local board of education resolution imposing a development impact fee shall collect the fee
- as a condition of development approval by such county or municipality. The proceeds of

any development impact fee imposed pursuant to this Paragraph shall be used to pay for
a share of the cost of additional educational facilities to serve new growth and development

20 in the same area in which such fee is imposed."

SECTION 2.

- 22 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as
- 23 provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the
- 24 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:
- 25 "( ) YES Shall the Constitution of Georgia be amended so as to provide that the
- General Assembly may by general law authorize local boards of education
- 27 () NO to impose, levy, and collect development impact fees, subject to local
- referendum, and use the proceeds to pay for a share of the cost of additional educational facilities?"
- 29 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."
- 30 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If
- 31 such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall
- 32 become a part of the Constitution of this state.
