A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating and commending Dorothy Moore for receiving the 2021 Nikki T. Randall
2 Servant Leader Award; and for other purposes.

4 female elected to the General Assembly from middle Georgia, and over her 17 years of
5 service as a legislator, she held numerous leadership positions, including chair of the Georgia
6 Legislative Women's Caucus; and

7 WHEREAS, every year during Women's History Month, the Georgia Legislative Women's
8 Caucus recognizes outstanding women in Georgia who exemplify the leadership and
9 inspiration embodied by Representative Randall; and

10 WHEREAS, Dorothy Moore has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours
11 of her time, talents, and energy toward the betterment of her community and state, as
12 evidenced by her many years of superlative service in social work administration and with
13 numerous organizations, including Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority Inc., the Rockdale-Newton
14 Section of the National Council of Negro Women, and Emory's Goizueta Alzheimer's
15 Disease Research Center; and

16 WHEREAS, among her many contributions, she has organized numerous prestigious
17 fundraising events, collaborated with local churches, and engaged with affluent community
18 leaders in the name of minority outreach medical programs; and

19 WHEREAS, she has earned distinction and numerous awards as a result of her dedication
20 to excellence, including the Sisters by Choice 2013 Outstanding Award, the Alpha Kappa
21 Alpha Sorority Inc. Chi Tau Omega Chapter 2017 Outstanding Service Award, and more;

23 WHEREAS, Dorothy is a woman of unassuming greatness whose humble acts of kindness
24 and generosity have uplifted the entire Atlanta community; and

25 WHEREAS, she has established a glowing reputation of renown throughout Georgia for her
26 tireless dedication to improving the quality of life within her community, exhibiting a deep
27 personal commitment to the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

28 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
29 extraordinary servant leader be appropriately recognized.

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
31 congratulate and commend Dorothy Moore for receiving the 2021 Nikki T. Randall Servant
32 Leader Award and extend best wishes for her continued success.
