- 3 provide for the submission of this amendment for ratification or rejection; and for other

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

7 Article I, Section II, Paragraph VIII of the Constitution is amended by adding a new

8 subparagraph to read as follows:

9 "(e) The General Assembly may provide by law for the operation and regulation of

pari-mutuel wagering on horse racing and casino gambling in this state by or on behalf of

the state only and for any matters relating to such activities. The General Assembly shall

provide for the dedication of the net revenues and proceeds derived from such activities

after payment of all necessary operating expenses and distributions, purses, and cash prizes

to the specific purposes set forth in this subparagraph. Such net revenues and proceeds

shall not be subject to Article III, Section IX, Paragraph IV(c); Article III, Section IX,

Paragraph VI(a); or Article VII, Section III, Paragraph II, except that the net revenues and

proceeds after payment of all necessary operating expenses and distributions, purses, and

cash prizes shall be subject to Article VII, Section III, Paragraph II. Such net revenues and

proceeds shall be separately accounted for and shall be specifically identified by the

Governor in the annual budget presented to the General Assembly as a separate budget

category entitled 'Pari-mutuel Wagering and Casino Gambling Proceeds,' and the Governor

shall make specific recommendations regarding the appropriation of such net revenues and

proceeds. Such net revenues and proceeds shall be used to supplement, not supplant,

25 (1) Tuition scholarships, grants, or loans to citizens of this state to enable such citizens

26 <u>to attend colleges and universities located within this state, regardless of whether such</u>

28 of Georgia, or to attend institutions operated under the authority of the Technical College 29 System of Georgia; and 30 (2) Voluntary pre-kindergarten. 31 The General Assembly shall appropriate all such net revenues and proceeds in accordance with law." 32 33 **SECTION 2.** 34 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as 35 provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the 36 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following: 37 "() YES Shall the Constitution of Georgia be amended so as to authorize the General 38 Assembly to provide by law for pari-mutuel wagering on horse racing and 39 () NO casino gambling in this state and for the use of the net revenues and 40 proceeds only for the purposes of funding higher education tuition 41 scholarships, grants, or loans and voluntary pre-kindergarten programs?" All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes." 42 43 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If

such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall

become a part of the Constitution of this state.
