## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Chardae Regina "Prima" Sanders; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia continues to mourn the loss of one of its most distinguished  
3 citizens with the passing of Chardae Regina "Prima" Sanders on February 13, 2021; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Chardae Regina "Prima" Sanders was born on November 6, 1986, and she  
5 pursued higher education at Georgia State University and Kennesaw State University,  
6 earning degrees in communications; and
- 7 WHEREAS, despite her own medical challenges, she served as an ambassador for the  
8 American Association of Kidney Patients and advocate for the National Kidney Foundation,  
9 where she was given the honor of speaking to the United States Congress about kidney  
10 disease awareness; and
- 11 WHEREAS, she gave inspiration to many through her high ideals, morals, and deep concern  
12 for her fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding she demonstrated to  
13 her family and friends were admired by others; and

14 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
15 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example she made of her life,  
16 she made this world a better place in which to live; and

17 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous woman, Chardae Regina "Prima" Sanders will  
18 long be remembered for her love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed  
19 by all who had the great fortune of knowing her.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
21 join in honoring the life and memory of Chardae Regina "Prima" Sanders and express their  
22 deepest and most sincere regret at her passing.
