A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the Georgia AIDS Coalition; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Georgia AIDS Coalition is a nonprofit Georgia corporation recognized as
- 3 a 501(c)(3) organization by the Internal Revenue Service for its work in improving the health
- 4 care of citizens of this state with AIDS, HIV, and other diseases through its leadership role
- 5 in formulating public policy, promoting education programs, and delivering support services
- 6 regarding these diseases; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the Georgia AIDS Coalition has focused on its work since 2013 on the coastal
- 8 and southeast areas of this state through the auspices of a multiyear grant from the Elton John
- 9 AIDS Foundation, during which time the Georgia AIDS Coalition has been an important
- 10 resource to the coastal and southeast health districts in their mission of providing health
- services directed to citizens with AIDS, HIV, and similar diseases; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the Georgia AIDS Coalition has also worked with Savannah State University,
- 13 Armstrong University, and Georgia Southern University, as well as a coalition of local
- 14 community based organizations, including First City Network, Care, Inc., Savannah PRIDE,
- 15 Union Mission, TEE, Phoenix House, and Rape Crisis to assist those institutions with local
- 16 educational opportunities to deal with AIDS and HIV, as these diseases impact youth,
- 17 minorities, and other at-risk communities; and
- 18 WHEREAS, an important component of the Georgia AIDS Coalition's responsibilities with
- 19 the Elton John AIDS Coalition grant is to train citizens from southeastern Georgia in the art
- 20 of articulating their health care needs so they can, in turn, vocalize their concerns to local and
- 21 state officials, an initiative which is highlighted by a visit to the state capitol during the
- 22 General Assembly to educate their state senators and representatives on the health issues
- 23 which impact their constituencies.
