A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the Georgia peanut industry and recognizing March 1, 2013, as Peanut Butter
- 2 and Jelly Day at the capitol; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, peanuts and peanut products are recognized throughout our nation and the
- 4 world as an appetizing and nutritious food, providing protein and other nutrients as part of
- 5 a well-balanced diet; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia leads the United States in peanut production, producing
- 7 nearly 50 percent of the total supply in the nation. Further, our state leads the nation in
- 8 peanut exports, supplying 50 percent of the U.S. peanut exports and contributing over \$160
- 9 million toward our nation's balance of trade; and
- 10 WHEREAS, peanut production is the largest single cash food row crop in Georgia with gross
- 11 farm receipts totaling hundreds of millions of dollars; and
- 12 WHEREAS, more than 250 Georgia companies engaged in warehousing, processing,
- manufacturing, and marketing totally depend on the peanut industry, and hundreds of other
- 14 Georgia companies that engage in financing, supplying, distributing, and transporting are
- 15 dependent to some extent on the peanut industry; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the Georgia peanut industry has played a significant role in the economic
- 17 growth and prosperity of our state, contributing an estimated \$1 billion to the Georgia
- 18 economy and supporting the livelihood of more than 150,000 Georgians.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 20 commend the peanut industry for its outstanding contributions to the economic health of the
- 21 State of Georgia and recognize March 1, 2013, as Peanut Butter and Jelly Day at the capitol.
