A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the Atlanta Junior Rowing Association; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Atlanta Junior Rowing Association is a nonprofit organization dedicated to
- 3 introducing middle and high school students throughout metro Atlanta to the Olympic sport
- 4 of rowing; and this spring, AJRA is completing its 27th year of rowing, making it one of the
- 5 oldest and currently the largest youth rowing group in the State of Georgia; and
- 6 WHEREAS, AJRA began in 1988 with a handful of rowers and has now grown to more than
- 7 200 youth from 30 middle and high schools across Atlanta participating in the program in
- 8 the fall and spring seasons; and
- 9 WHEREAS, about 140 of those rowers compete at regattas throughout the Southeast, with
- 10 the remainder in the recreational high school team and middle school development program;
- 11 and
- 12 WHEREAS, additionally, 250-300 students ages 12-18 participate in their Learn to Row
- program each summer, which has been offered for the past 17 consecutive years; and
- 14 WHEREAS, AJRA also gives back to the community by offering rowing merit badge clinics
- 15 to Boy Scouts and participating in service projects, such as Adopt-a-Road and Row for the
- 16 Cure; and
- 17 WHEREAS, recent AJRA alumni are currently rowing at the United States Naval Academy,
- 18 the United States Coast Guard Academy, the United States Military Academy at West Point,
- 19 Brown, Clemson University, Georgetown, Harvard, Northeastern, the Ohio State University,
- 20 Stanford, UCLA, the University of Louisville, the University of Michigan, the University of
- 21 Southern California, the University of Tennessee, the University of Virginia, and Yale,
- among others; and
