## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February 21, 2023, as Capitol Conservation Day; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, on Capitol Conservation Day, we reflect on the relationship between  
3 conservation and the health and economic growth of our state; and

4 WHEREAS, the 250 environmental and conservation organizations that compose the  
5 20-year-old Georgia Water Coalition are committed to assuring that the water we drink, the  
6 air we breathe, and the soil in which we grow food is protected for generations to come; and

7 WHEREAS, for the past 10 years, members of these environmental groups have gathered at  
8 the state capitol to discuss current conservation issues and pending legislation. They are  
9 committed to educating our citizens and communities about the importance of protecting and  
10 preserving Georgia's natural resources; and

11 WHEREAS, representatives of these organizations from across the state will be meeting at  
12 the state capitol on February 21, 2023.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
14 recognize February 21, 2023, as Capitol Conservation Day.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed  
16 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the public and the  
17 press.
