- 16 new technology in the libraries, available to the people of Clayton County, going from
- 17 170,000 items in 1980 to 477,420 in 2010; and
- 18 WHEREAS, she has been a wonderful asset to the Clayton County Library System, making
- 19 sure to extend its service to every person; and
- 20 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding career and
- 21 accomplishments of this remarkable individual be appropriately recognized.
