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Senate Resolution 298

A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the Senate Annexation Study Committee; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, pressure from growth and development often results in the annexation of
- 3 unincorporated areas of a county without due consideration of the voices of local property
- 4 owners who are adversely impacted by the decisions of the governing body of a local
- 5 government for which they have no say in electing; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the General Assembly enacted Article 7 of Chapter 36 of Title 36 of the Official
- 7 Code of Georgia Annotated in 2007 to provide an annexation dispute resolution procedure;
- 8 and
- 9 WHEREAS, such annexation dispute resolution procedure has not been amended or subject
- 10 to legislative review since its enactment; and
- 11 WHEREAS, a thorough study of this annexation dispute resolution procedure is overdue so
- 12 as to determine what appropriate revisions are needed to avoid the abuse of citizens of this
- 13 state.

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- 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:
- 15 (1) **Creation of Senate study committee.** There is created the Senate Annexation Study
- 16 Committee.
- 17 (2) **Members and officers.** The committee shall be composed of five members of the
- 18 Senate to be appointed by the President of the Senate. The President shall designate one
- of such members as chairperson of the committee.
- 20 (3) **Powers and duties.** The committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs,
- 21 issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action or
- legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate.
- 23 (4) **Meetings.** The chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee. The committee
- may conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or
- convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and
- accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution.
- 27 (5) Allowances and funding.
- 28 (A) The legislative members of the committee shall receive the allowances provided
- for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated.
- 30 (B) The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by any member
- of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized. Funds
- 32 necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from funds
- appropriated to the Senate.
- 34 (6) **Report.**
- 35 (A) In the event the committee adopts any specific findings or recommendations that
- include suggestions for proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file a report of the
- 37 same prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution, subject to
- subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.

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39 (B) In the event the committee adopts a report that does not include suggestions for 40 proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file the report, subject to subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.

- 42 (C) No report shall be filed unless the same has been approved prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution by majority vote of a quorum of the committee.
- A report so approved shall be signed by the chairperson of the committee and filed with
- the Secretary of the Senate. Any member of the committee may file a minority report
- that shall accompany the majority report.
- 47 (D) In the absence of an approved report, the chairperson may file with the Secretary
- of the Senate copies of the minutes of the meetings of the committee in lieu thereof.
- 49 (7) **Abolishment.** The committee shall stand abolished on December 1, 2021.
