## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and memory of Sergeant Barry Henderson and dedicating an intersection  
2 in his memory; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest citizens and most dedicated law  
4 enforcement officers with the untimely passing of Sergeant Barry Henderson on March 9,  
5 2021; and

6 WHEREAS, Sergeant Henderson was highly regarded by the citizens of his community and  
7 state and by local government officials as a person of unquestioned integrity and dedication  
8 to the sound principles of law enforcement; and

9 WHEREAS, he served with honor and distinction with the Polk County Sheriffs Office; and

10 WHEREAS, Sergeant Henderson exhibited extraordinary devotion to public service,  
11 outstanding loyalty, fine leadership, and meticulous attention to detail in all of his duties; and

12 WHEREAS, he will long be remembered for his inspiring commitment to the welfare of  
13 others, which stands as a shining example of the positive effect law enforcement  
14 professionals have on the lives and well-being of others; and

15 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished  
16 Georgian be appropriately recognized by dedicating an intersection in his memory.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL  
18 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the intersection at SR 6/US 278 and SR 101/6BU in Polk  
19 County is dedicated as the Sergeant Barry Henderson Memorial Intersection.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and  
21 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Sergeant Barry Henderson  
22 Memorial Intersection.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed  
24 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the family of  
25 Sergeant Barry Henderson and to the Department of Transportation.
