A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending National Association of Chinese-American's chairwoman and
- 2 Asian Community Leader Lani Wong for her decades of public service and swift assistance
- 3 in the fight against the COVID-19 pandemic; and for other purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, Lani Wong has been serving the interests of the Asian American community
- 5 for over 40 years by involving Asian Americans in the American political process and by
- 6 serving both on the Human Relations Commission and as chair of the first Georgia
- 7 Asian-American Affairs Commission; she was also named to the Asian-American
- 8 Commission for a New Georgia; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Lani Wong has also sought to advance opportunities for women in her local
- 10 community throughout her service, including serving six years on the board of directors at
- 11 The Atlanta Women's Foundation; she has been recognized and honored with the first
- 12 Luminary Award from Global Executive Women as well as the Georgia Pioneer Award from
- 13 the National Organization of Black Elected Legislators-Women; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Lani Wong has been recognized for her hard work on the local, national, and
- 15 international levels; and

16 WHEREAS, her most recent accomplishments include having a significant positive impact 17 on the COVID-19 relief efforts in Georgia through her leadership in the National Association 18 of Chinese-Americans; supporting hospitals and front-line workers; donating \$5,000 to 19 Mercy Care Atlanta; delivering 75,000 surgical and N95 masks to various organizations, 20 such as Emory Hospital, Grady Hospital, Saint Joseph's Hospital, and the Chamblee Police 21 Department, to name a few; donating \$20,000 in total to the Georgia State Students 22 Emergency Assistance Fund; sending \$5,000 to the Atlanta Food Bank to help provide up 23 to 20,000 meals, purchase additional food, and add special mobile pantries; donating \$2,500 24 to Dresden Elementary School to help feed the food-insecure families of the school; and 25 donating \$2,500 to Los Vecinos de Buford Highway to help families through the Rental 26 Assistance Program and food distribution.

- 28 recognize and commend Lani Wong for her public service to Georgia and beyond and
- 29 encourage her continued dedication to helping others.
