- 1 Honoring the life of Corporal Dennis "Denny" R. Wallin and dedicating a road in his
- 2 memory; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, Corporal Dennis "Denny" R. Wallin was born on September 19, 1948, in
- 4 LaFayette, Georgia, the beloved son of Pauline and Raymond Wallin; and
- 5 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United
- 6 States Marine Corps as a rifleman and after one week of returning home from deployment
- 7 in the Vietnam War, he volunteered to return on a special mission to assist in the retrieval of
- 8 American soldiers killed in action; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Corporal Wallin made the ultimate sacrifice for his country on February 6,
- 10 1968, in Quang Nam Province, Vietnam, at only 19 years of age after taking on direct fire
- while helping recover his fallen comrades; and
- 12 WHEREAS, he demonstrated a deep personal commitment to protecting democracy and a
- willingness to sacrifice his own personal safety and comfort to ensure the well-being of his
- 14 fellow man; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Corporal Wallin embodied the spirit of service, willing to find meaning in
- something greater than himself, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable
- and distinguished American be recognized appropriately by dedicating a road in his memory.
- 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
- 19 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the portion of Highway 136 in Walker County is dedicated
- as the CPL Dennis "Denny" R. Wallin, USMC Memorial Highway.
