A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Rebecca "Becky" Lee for being named one of the Career Women's Network
2 of Macon Women of Achievement for 2013; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Rebecca "Becky" Lee has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for
4 the vital role that she has played in leadership and her deep personal commitment to the
5 welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, she began her career as an administrative manager for the Mead Corporation
7 from 1978 to 1990, and she implemented an employee involvement program that reduced
8 grievance activity and increased productivity, which became the model used throughout the
9 Paperboard Division; and

10 WHEREAS, Becky is currently the vice president of economic development programs for
11 Central Georgia Technical College; and

12 WHEREAS, she has been involved in the community in other ways, including serving as a
13 member of the Board Development Committee of the Girl Scouts of Historic Georgia,
14 previous site based mentor for Big Brothers Big Sisters, the past board president of the
15 Macon Literacy Action Plan/Project Read, past chair of the Macon 2000 Partnership
16 Certified Literate Community Plan, and past board member of the Central Georgia Chapter
17 of the American Red Cross; and

18 WHEREAS, Becky helped launch Kids Voting Georgia, developed a Georgia training
19 program for electronic benefit transfers, and led the formation of the Middle Georgia Youth
20 Apprenticeship Program for the area aerospace industry, where she was a strong advocate
21 for women in traditionally male dominated careers; and

22 WHEREAS, she is an outstanding individual and an inspiration to women, and it is
23 abundantly fitting and proper that she be appropriately recognized.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
25 commend Rebecca Lee for being named one of the Career Women's Network of Macon
26 Women of Achievement for 2013 and extend to her best wishes for future success.
