A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Dawn Bryson; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, our nation's security continues to rely on patriotic men and women who put
3 their personal lives on hold in order to place themselves in harm's way to protect the
4 freedoms that all United States citizens cherish; and

5 WHEREAS, Dawn Bryson valiantly and courageously served as a guardian of this nation's
6 freedom and liberty with the United States Army for 15 years, retiring as a sergeant on
7 January 9, 1995; and

8 WHEREAS, throughout her distinguished career, Dawn served through numerous
9 assignments around the United States, demonstrating a deep personal commitment to the
10 well-being of her fellow citizens, servicemen, and servicewomen; and

11 WHEREAS, her duties included serving as the assistant non-commissioned officer in charge
12 of the Allen, Weeks, and Cowan dental clinics as well as the non-commissioned officer in
13 charge of the Pine Bluff Arsenal at Fort Chaffee National Guard/Reserves and Fort Smith;

15 WHEREAS, for her dedicated service to the military, she earned the Army Achievement
16 Medal with three Oak Leaf Clusters as well as the Army Commendation Medal; and

17 WHEREAS, following her retirement from service, this outstanding individual went on to
18 find success in the customer service and financial asset management industries; and

19 WHEREAS, this remarkable citizen has established a glowing reputation of renown
20 throughout Georgia for her dedication and high ideals; and

21 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
22 extraordinary veteran be appropriately recognized.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
24 recognize Dawn Bryson in celebration of Women Veteran's Day on February 16, 2021;
25 commend her for her effective, unselfish, and dedicated public service to the State of Georgia
26 and this nation; and extend the most sincere best wishes for continued health and happiness.
