## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the Senate Study Committee on Community Schools; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the provision of public education for the citizens is a primary obligation of the
- 3 State of Georgia; and
- 4 WHEREAS, in fulfilling such primary obligation, the state provides financial assistance and
- 5 may enact laws pursuant to which funds may be expended; and
- 6 WHEREAS, community schools chosen by parents for the education of their children are a
- 7 critical component in this state's efforts to provide access to an array of efficient and
- 8 high-quality choices for the education of its citizens; and
- 9 WHEREAS, community schools focus on the entire child, under the premise that if the basic
- 10 needs of a student are not met, the student will not be able to focus or succeed in the
- 11 classroom; and
- 12 WHEREAS, community school programming relies on meaningful and sustained
- 13 collaboration between the school and community stakeholders, including local governmental
- 14 units, civic engagement organizations, businesses, and social service providers and the
- 15 establishment and maintenance of partnerships with institutions, such as universities,
- 16 hospitals, museums, corporations, community organizations, or other community partners,
- 17 to further the development and implementation of community school programming; and
- 18 WHEREAS, community schools can provide valuable educational options and learning
- 19 opportunities that best fit the individual needs of children.
- 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:
- 21 (1) **Creation of Senate study committee**. There is created the Senate Study Committee
- on Community Schools.

23 (2) **Members and officers.** The committee shall be composed of five members of the

- Senate to be appointed by the President of the Senate. The President shall designate a
- legislative member of the committee as chairperson of the committee.
- 26 (3) **Powers and duties.** The committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs,
- issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action or
- legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate.
- 29 (4) **Meetings.** The chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee. The committee
- may conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or
- 31 convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and
- accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution.
- 33 (5) **Allowances and funding.** The legislative members of the committee shall receive
- 34 the allowances provided for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 35 Annotated. The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by any
- member of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized.
- Funds necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from funds
- appropriated to the Senate.
- 39 (6) **Report.**
- 40 (A) In the event the committee adopts any specific findings or recommendations that
- 41 include suggestions for proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file a report of the
- same prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution, subject to
- subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.
- (B) In the event the committee adopts a report that does not include suggestions for
- proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file the report, subject to subparagraph (C)
- of this paragraph.
- 47 (C) No report shall be filed unless the same has been approved prior to the date of
- abolishment specified in this resolution by majority vote of a quorum of the committee.
- 49 A report so approved shall be signed by the chairperson of the committee and filed with
- 50 the Secretary of the Senate.
- 51 (D) In the absence of an approved report, the chairperson may file with the Secretary
- of the Senate a copy of the minutes of the meetings of the committee in lieu thereof.
- 53 (7) **Abolishment**. The committee shall stand abolished on December 1, 2019.
