A RESOLUTION

1 Celebrating the anniversary of Bangladesh's 50th year of independence and Founding Leader
2 Sheikh Mujibur Rahman's 100th birthday anniversary; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, as the first President of Bangladesh and Father of the Nation of Bangladesh,
4 Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman was the driving force behind Bangladesh's
5 independence; and

6 WHEREAS, we recognize Minto Rahman, Md. Ali Hossain, Mohammed Yusuf, M.A.
7 Hassan, Md. Belayet Hossain, Muhammed Harun-ur-Rashid, and Mohammad Hossain, who
8 are proud Bangladeshi Americans and Georgia residents who were Freedom Fighters during
9 the liberation movement of Bangladesh in 1971; and

10 WHEREAS, their contributions and sacrifices during the war and their commitment to civic
11 engagement in the Bangladeshi community of Georgia have had a significant positive
12 impact; and

13 WHEREAS, we also recognize the contributions of the late Freedom Fighters Salauddin
14 Jamil, Anwarul Hoque, Md. Arkan Ali, and Nazrul Islam of Georgia for their contributions

15 to the liberation of Bangladesh and their service to the Bangladeshi community in Georgia;

17 WHEREAS, Bangladeshi Americans in Georgia and in the United States of America have
18 made significant contributions and accomplishments in the fields of arts, science, history, and
19 technology.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
21 congratulate the people of Bangladesh and the Georgians of Bangladesh descent and join in
22 the celebration of the anniversary of Bangladesh's 50th year of independence and Founding
23 Leader Sheikh Mujibur Rahman's 100th birthday anniversary.
