A RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Georgia so as to clarify that only
- 2 citizens of the United States shall have a right to vote in elections in this state; to provide for
- 3 related matters; to provide for the submission of this amendment for ratification or rejection;
- 4 and for other purposes.

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article II, Section I of the Constitution is amended by revising Paragraph II as follows:
- 8 "Paragraph II. *Right to register and vote*. Every person who is a citizen Only individuals
- 9 who are citizens of the United States and a resident residents of Georgia as defined by law.
- who is are at least 18 years of age and not disenfranchised by this article, and who meets
- meet minimum residency requirements as provided by law shall be entitled to vote at any
- 12 election by the people. The General Assembly shall provide by law for the registration of
- 13 electors."
- 14 SECTION 2.
- 15 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as
- 16 provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the
- 17 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:

- "() YES Shall the Constitution of Georgia be amended so as to clarify that only
 () NO citizens of the United States shall have a right to vote in elections in the State
 of Georgia?"
- 21 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."
- 22 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If
- 23 such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall
- 24 become a part of the Constitution of this state.
