- 4 of the 1 percent of Americans who answered their nation's call and was stationed at Fort
- 5 Wainwright as a part of the United States Army Missile Battalion; and

- 8 where electrical sparks were flying and a generator would not shut down; and

- 10 his own accord and shut down the generator, thereby defusing the situation and saving the
- 11 lives of numerous military personnel; and
- 12 WHEREAS, as a result of his heroism, United States Senator Paul Coverdell recommended
- 13 Jarrett Blankenship for receipt of the Soldier's Medal; and
- 14 WHEREAS, all Americans owe a debt of gratitude to the men and women of the United
- 15 States Armed Forces who risk their lives in the defense of freedom and to secure the
- 16 blessings of liberty for this nation and other peoples of the world; and
- 17 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
- 18 remarkable and distinguished American be recognized appropriately.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 20 recognize and commend Army Veteran Jarrett Blankenship for the selfless dedication he
- 21 exhibited in carrying out the difficult duties of his vocation as a hometown hero and
