A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the City of Stockbridge, Georgia; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the City of Stockbridge is located in the northern part of Henry County,
3 Georgia, which was founded on May 15, 1821; Stockbridge was incorporated as a town in
4 1895 and as a city on August 6, 1920; and

5 WHEREAS, the motto for the City of Stockbridge is "Where community connects," and this
6 is exemplified by its supportive economic development, excellent public services, and
7 fabulous small town hospitality; citizens take pride in the community and quality businesses,
8 which are reasons why Stockbridge continues to enjoy tremendous growth; and

9 WHEREAS, the City of Stockbridge strives to be the most progressive business and family
10 oriented community in metro Atlanta and places a focus on enhanced quality of life
11 initiatives, which promote a sustainable "Live, Work, Play" environment; and

12 WHEREAS, the City of Stockbridge strives to provide visionary leadership and superior
13 municipal services that enhance the quality of life for citizens while creating a welcoming
14 business atmosphere focused on sustainability and expansion of tourism and cultural events;

16 WHEREAS, the economic goals of the City of Stockbridge include encouraging a healthy
17 mix of commercial, retail, restaurant, and residential uses within the commercial district.
