A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the Cherokee County School District for being a 2015 Georgia Green Ribbon
- 2 School District and for its great work in environmental education and sustainability; and for
- 3 other purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, the aim of United States Department of Education Green Ribbon Schools is to
- 5 inspire schools, districts, and institutions of higher education to strive for 21st century
- 6 excellence by highlighting exemplary practices and resources that all can employ; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the Green Ribbon award recognizes schools, districts, and institutions of higher
- 8 education that reduce environmental impact and costs; improve the health and wellness of
- 9 schools, students, and staff; and provide environmental education which teaches many
- disciplines and is especially good at effectively incorporating STEM, civic skills, and green
- 11 career pathways. The combined achievement in all three of these areas serves as the basis
- 12 for recognition; and
- 13 WHEREAS, the Cherokee County School District was one of two Georgia school districts
- 14 named a Georgia Green Ribbon School for the year 2015; and
- 15 WHEREAS, the core of the Cherokee County School District's mission statement is "to
- enable all students to become contributing citizens who can communicate effectively, gather
- and use information, make responsible decisions, utilize technology effectively, and adapt
- 18 to the challenges of the future"; and
- 19 WHEREAS, these district-wide initiatives include efforts to "reduce, reuse, recycle, and
- 20 rethink," such as reducing waste, including paper, ink, copiers, and energy; and
- 21 WHEREAS, all Cherokee County School District facilities meet the American Society of
- Heating, Refrigerating, and Air-Conditioning Engineers standards and use automated energy

23 management facilities, and all facilities have been retrofitted with energy efficient and

- 24 cost-effective lighting systems and low-flow bathroom fixtures; and
- 25 WHEREAS, the Campaign's Clean Air Schools programs are available to all Cherokee
- 26 County School District schools and include programs to promote bus ridership, carpooling
- 27 to school, and no-idling school zones, and the Cherokee County School District promotes
- 28 these programs in its schools and community; and
- 29 WHEREAS, curriculum examples of its commitment to environmental education include the
- 30 third grade unit on pollution and conservation, the seventh grade unit on ecology, the high
- 31 school environmental sciences course, and the high school transportation course.
- 32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 33 commend the Cherokee County School District for being a 2015 Georgia Green Ribbon
- 34 School District and recognize its commitment to inspiring and educating tomorrow's leaders
