- 3 WHEREAS, Rotary International is a worldwide organization of business and professional
- 4 leaders that provides humanitarian service, encourages high ethical standards in all vocations,
- 5 and helps build goodwill and peace in the world; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the object of the Rotary Club is to develop friendship and community, promote
- 7 high ethical standards in business and professions, and nurture the dedication to service in
- 8 each Rotarian's personal, business, and community life; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the Rotarian's primary motto is "Service Above Self," its secondary motto is
- 10 "One profits most who serves best"; and
- 11 WHEREAS, approximately 1.2 million Rotarians belong to more than 34,000 clubs in more
- than 200 countries and geographical areas; and
- WHEREAS, Rotarians develop community service projects that address many of today's
- most critical issues, such as children at risk, poverty and hunger, the environment, illiteracy,

- 16 WHEREAS, the Rotary Club of Claxton was founded in 1938 by a group of 15 young men
- 17 dedicated to fostering Rotary's philosophical cornerstone expressed through club service,

- 20 outstanding affiliate and as one of the district's most successful Rotary Clubs; and

- 23 WHEREAS, the Claxton Rotary Club has made a difference in their community over the
- 24 decades by undertaking youth programs, advancing economic development, sponsoring
- events that focus on the importance of agriculture in Evans County, advocating for the Evans
- 26 County Hospital, promoting tourism, and supporting efforts to see that local citizens were
- 27 immunized against polio; and
- 28 WHEREAS, club members continue to raise funds through various projects, including the
- 29 annual Claxton Rotary/Chamber of Commerce Auction, to help fund scholarship awards for
- 30 local high school students; to promote the Interact Clubs, bringing together young people to
