1 Recognizing and commending Senator Al Scott on his outstanding public service; and for

3 WHEREAS, Senator Scott has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for the vital

4 role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the welfare of the5 citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, he has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,

8 dramatically by his superlative service in the General Assembly of Georgia; and

19 WHEREAS, this distinguished gentleman has given inspiration to many through his high 20 ideals, morals, and deep concern for his fellow citizens, and he possesses the vast wisdom 21 which only comes through experience and the strength of character which is achieved 22 through overcoming the many challenges of life; and 19

- 25 WHEREAS, Senator Scott has served with honor and distinction with the General Assembly
