## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending the Primitive Baptists in the State of Georgia; and for other
- 2 purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the Primitive Baptists in the State of Georgia, led by a delegation of Elders in
- 4 the denomination as well as members of the various Primitive Baptist congregations, had a
- 5 vision of a need for a care community for the elderly and orphans in South Georgia and
- 6 beyond; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the first building established to house the elderly was founded as Faith Cottage
- 8 and became known as Bethany Home for Ladies, followed by the purchase of the Dr.
- 9 Thompson Hospital in Millen, which became known as Bethany Home for Men; and
- 10 WHEREAS, in 1989, the construction of a new care community was begun, which
- 11 eventually was completed in 1992 and became known as Bethany Nursing Center of Vidalia,
- 12 housing both men and women; subsequently, renovations were completed on the Dr.
- 13 Thompson Hospital in Millen, which became known as Bethany Nursing Center of Millen,
- 14 representing what is believed to have been the first home established by a church for the care
- 15 of the aged in the State of Georgia; and

16 WHEREAS, in 2009, the Board of Trustees had a vision to expand the senior care provided

- 17 by Bethany to Statesboro, Bulloch County, and purchased a tract of property known as the
- 18 Neville Family Farm consisting of 63 acres from the Neville Family, representing the largest
- 19 single undeveloped tract within the city limits of Statesboro, and began the process of
- 20 planning and providing a senior community on this tract; and
- 21 WHEREAS, in 2014, the Board of Trustees began the construction of what is now a 44,000
- square foot building representing the only certified Assisted Living Community within the
- 23 City of Statesboro, Bulloch County; and
- 24 WHEREAS, in 2019, the Board of Trustees again had a vision to expand the senior care
- 25 provided on the Statesboro, Bulloch County, campus and opened nine Independent Living
- 26 Cottages on the campus of Bethany, known as The Cottages at Bethany; and
- 27 WHEREAS, in 2023, the year of the centennial of the organization as a whole, the Board of
- 28 Trustees had a vision become a reality in the expansion of the provision of Independent
- 29 Living by the opening of 14 additional Cottages, bringing the total of Independent Living on
- 30 the campus to 23 Cottages, all known as The Cottages at Bethany; and
- 31 WHEREAS, under the leadership of the Board of Trustees of Bethany during the past 100
- years, Bethany continues to fulfill the Vision, Mission, and Values of the organization that
- were begun in 1923 in the Invitation "to engage in a faithful and joyous Community of Care,"
- 34 having served thousands of families and their loved ones during a most vulnerable time in
- 35 their lives while adhering to the Beliefs of Bethany to "Love God and love your neighbor,
- 36 Honor your Father and Mother, and It all starts with Faith."
