A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Kids' Chance of Georgia and recognizing its 25th anniversary; and for other

2 purposes.

WHEREAS, Robert Clyatt, a workers' compensation attorney from Valdosta, Georgia,
founded the first Kids' Chance organization in 1988; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Clyatt formed the organization after witnessing the life-shattering impact

6 that a serious workplace injury had on the children of seriously or fatally injured workers,
7 who were now faced with the difficulty of having to fund their own education; and

8 WHEREAS, with the assistance of the Workers' Compensation Section of the Georgia Bar,

9 Mr. Clyatt incorporated Kids' Chance of Georgia and began raising money to fund

10 educational scholarships for the children of injured Georgia workers; and

WHEREAS, Kids' Chance of Georgia has reached out to other states, encouraging and
assisting them as they establish their own Kids' Chance organizations; and

13 WHEREAS, 25 states have organized Kids' Chance programs that actively provide 14 need-based scholarships to the families of seriously injured workers, and new Kids' Chance 15 organizations are formed each year; and

16 WHEREAS, since 1988, Kids' Chance of Georgia has awarded more than 600 scholarships,

17 raised nearly \$4 million, and established an endowment fund; and

18 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper for the outstanding service of Kids' Chance19 of Georgia to be appropriately recognized.

- 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 21 commend Kids' Chance of Georgia for its dedication to the welfare of Georgia children and
- 22 celebrate its 25th anniversary.
- 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 24 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Kids' Chance of Georgia.
